Mr. Herman Hu Sports Awards and Scholarships

Regulations

Mr. Herman Hu has donated HK\$300,000 to the University to establish the “Mr. Herman Hu Sports Awards and Scholarships” for outstanding student athletes who have outstanding sports achievement / performance and contributions during the academic year. The scholarship scheme shall be effective from the academic year 2010/11 for five consecutive years under the following regulations:

1. *There shall be two team awards, namely **Award for Men’s Tennis Team** and **Award for Women’s Tennis Team**, in recognition of the outstanding achievement of the CityU Men’s and Women’s Tennis Teams in inter-collegiate competitions. The value of the awards depends on the results as achieved by the Tennis Teams in the year:*

<i>Champion</i>	<i>:</i>	<i>HK\$15,000</i>
<i>Second</i>	<i>:</i>	<i>HK\$10,000</i>
<i>Third</i>	<i>:</i>	<i>HK\$5,000</i>

2. *There shall be two **Tennis Most Valuable Players** in the amount of HK\$5,000@ per annum, with one for a male student and the other for a female student, who met the following criteria:*
 - i. *demonstrated good sports performance and achievements in local or international competitions; and*
 - ii. *have proven leadership and sportsmanship in the CityU tennis team; and*
 - iii. *obtained satisfactory academic performance.*
3. *There shall be TWO to THREE **Athlete Awards** and the value of each award shall be HK\$10,000. The Awards shall be granted to athletes who shall meet the following criteria :*
 - i. *demonstrated good sports performance and achievements in local or international competitions; and*
 - ii. *have proven leadership and sportsmanship in the CityU sports team(s); and*
 - iii. *obtained satisfactory academic performance with CGPA 2.5 or above.*
4. *Nominations shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Team and the winners of the awards will be selected by a selection panel to be chaired by Associate Director (Physical Education) of Student Development Services.*

5. *The donor shall be invited to present the scholarships in the annual CityU Sports Team Annual Prize Presentation Ceremony to be held in April each year.*

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.
