Dr. Lam Kwok Pun Memorial Badminton Awards

Regulations

With effect from the 2012/13 academic year, Mr. L.O. Leung has newly injected HK\$150,000 into the University and the donation fund together with the matching grant will be used to recognize the achievement of the badminton team and student athletes. The following regulations shall apply as of 2023/24:

1. *There shall be **two Team Awards** in recognition of the outstanding achievement of the CityU Men's and Women's Badminton Teams in inter-collegiate competitions. The value of the awards shall depend on the results achieved by the Teams in the year:*
 - a) *Champion : HK\$10,000*
 - b) *Second : HK\$8,000*
 - c) *Third : HK\$5,000*

2. *There shall be **two Athlete Awards** and the value of each award shall be HK\$5,000. The Awards shall be granted to one male student and one female student, who met the following criteria:*
 - a) *demonstrated good sports performance and achievements in local or international competitions;*
 - b) *have proven leadership and sportsmanship in the CityU badminton team; and*
 - c) *obtained satisfactory academic performance in a UGC-funded programme, with CGPA 2.0 or above.*

3. *The nominations for the Team Awards and the Athlete Awards shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Team and the winners of the Athlete Awards will be selected by a selection panel.*

4. *The Awards shall be presented at the annual CityU Sports Team Ceremony cum Annual Gathering.*

Remarks:

- i. *The matching grant (if any) shall support the Badminton Awards for local students only.*

- ii. *With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.*
