Dr. Herman Hu Outstanding Student Athletes Entrance Scholarships

Regulations

Dr. Herman Hu has donated HK\$3,000,000 to the University to establish the "Dr. Herman Hu Outstanding Student Athletes Entrance Scholarships" for outstanding student athletes. The scholarship scheme is effective from the academic year 2010/11. The following regulations shall apply as of 2023/24:

- 1. The Scholarships are known as "Dr. Herman Hu Outstanding Student Athletes Entrance Scholarships" (胡曉明博士優秀運動員入學獎學金).
- 2. There shall be a maximum of FIVE scholarships annually. The value of each award* is HK\$20,000-HK\$40,000 per annum.
- 3. Eligible applicants for the scholarships are full-time UGC undergraduate freshmen who have been admitted to CityU via the University's Student Athlete Admission Scheme. One award is designated for a student athlete recruited for Tennis Team.
- 4. The scholarship is automatically renewed each year on condition that the student achieves (a) a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) at 2.5 or above by the end of Semester B each year; and (b) satisfactory sports performance as determined by the Physical Education Section of Student Development Services.
- 5. The award shall be paid by two equal instalments by crediting to students' personal bank account. The first instalment is payable in the middle of Semester A while the second is payable in the end of Semester B. Nevertheless, the Physical Education Section may reserve the right to withhold the payment for Semester B if student does not make satisfactory sports performance and team contribution in the academic year.
- 6. The scholarship is tenable for two to six years depending on the duration of the registered associate degree or bachelor degree programme of the student or until the completion of the associate degree / degree programme as enrolled, whichever is the shorter period. The scholarship may be suspended for any period when the student is absent from the University, such as enrolling in a job placement scheme or other interruption.
- 7. Nominations shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Team and the winners of the awards will be selected by a selection panel to be chaired by Associate Director (Physical Education) of Student Development Services.

<u>Remark</u>:

*The value of the award for student athlete with sports performance at Regional Level shall be HK\$20,000@; and the value of the award for student athlete with sports performance at International Level shall be HK\$40,000@.

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
