Stephen Hui Outstanding Student Athletes Scholarships

Regulations

Mr. Stephen Hui has donated HK\$500,000 to the University for establishing the "Stephen Hui Outstanding Student Athletes Scholarships" to support student-athletes who have outstanding sports achievements/performances to participate in sports training and competition without financial burden. The scholarship scheme is effective from the 2016/17 academic year. The following regulations shall apply as of 2023/24:

- 1. The Scholarships shall be known as "Stephen Hui Outstanding Student Athletes Scholarships" (許義鏞傑出運動員獎).
- 2. The value of each scholarship shall be HK\$10,000.
- 3. There shall be a maximum of SIX scholarships for outstanding student athletes who met the following criteria:
 - a) demonstrated outstanding sports performance and achievements in local or international competitions;
 - *b)* have proven leadership and sportsmanship in the CityU Sports Team(s);
 - c) obtained satisfactory academic performance with CGPA 2.0 or above; and
 - d) have financial needs.
- 4. Nominations shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Teams and the winners of the Scholarships will be selected by a selection panel formed by the University.
- 5. The donor shall be invited to present the Scholarships in the annual CityU Sports Team Annual Prize Presentation Ceremony.

Remarks:

- i. Total sum of the scholarships is HK\$500,000. Distribution of the scholarships shall complete in the academic year of 2025/26. In case the scholarships cannot be fully distributed in any year, the remaining sum will be carried forward for distribution in the next year.
- ii. With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
