



The Joint Bachelor's Degree Program between City University of Hong Kong (CityU) and Columbia University offers students an international undergraduate educational experience. The program draws upon elements both traditional and innovative, combining the academic rigor of two world-renowned universities with an attention to the roles that social and cultural traditions play in a student's intellectual formation.

Students complete the undergraduate curricula of both CityU and Columbia and earn two bachelor's degrees — one from each university.





During the first phase of the program, years one and two, students at CityU follow one of the majors noted below before applying for admission to the Joint Bachelor's Degree Program. Admitted students spend years three and four at Columbia, finishing core and major requirements for both degrees.

Students in this major are required to take additional courses and should expect to take longer than two years to complete their study at Columbia University.

The combination track requires a selection of six advanced courses (18 points). Students will combine computer science with another discipline in the arts, humanities, social or natural sciences by studying three courses in computer science and another three from another discipline.

Financial Aid

Students with excellent academic performance are eligible for scholarships at CityU based on academic merit or financial need. CityU students accepted to the Joint Bachelor's Degree Program may also apply for scholarships/awards that are designated for studies at Columbia.

COLUMBIA

Students in the program will be eligible to apply for need-based financial aid at Columbia University consistent with other students enrolled at the School of General Studies.

Application

An invitation to apply for admission to the Joint Bachelor's Degree Program will be sent to eligible students in the fall semester of their second year at CityU.
