Career Prospects

Graduates will have a solid foundation in the scientific study of language and will be prepared for careers that require both language skills and linguistics-related computer skills and other skills in language applications. In addition to opportunities in research and development, they will also have employment prospects in administrative and executive positions in various public and private sectors. They will have an important role to play in the language and information service sectors of Hong Kong, Greater China, and world-wide. Moreover, this programme is recognized by the Education Bureau as an English language major degree for the purpose of teaching in Hong Kong.

Main Subject Areas

1. Linguistics. Core courses include: Introduction to Linguistic Research, Fundamentals of Linguistics, Language in Society, Language and Mind, Phonetics, Phonology, Syntax and Semantics. **2. Language Applications.** Core courses include: Introduction to Language Technology and Computational Linguistics. At a more advanced level, students may choose from among courses such as Corpus Linguistics, Computational Lexicography, Sociolinguistics, Psycholinguistics, First / Second Language Acquisition and Computer-assisted Language Learning.
