

If the recommendation of credit units is approved, the students will continue to pay the prevailing tuition fees (or non-local rate for non-local students) until completion of the extra credit units permitted for the requested major.
- Notwithstanding the above, if the students subsequently pursue a double major / double degree, any extra credit units exceeding the original maximum credit limit permitted by the University should be paid on a self-financing basis.
