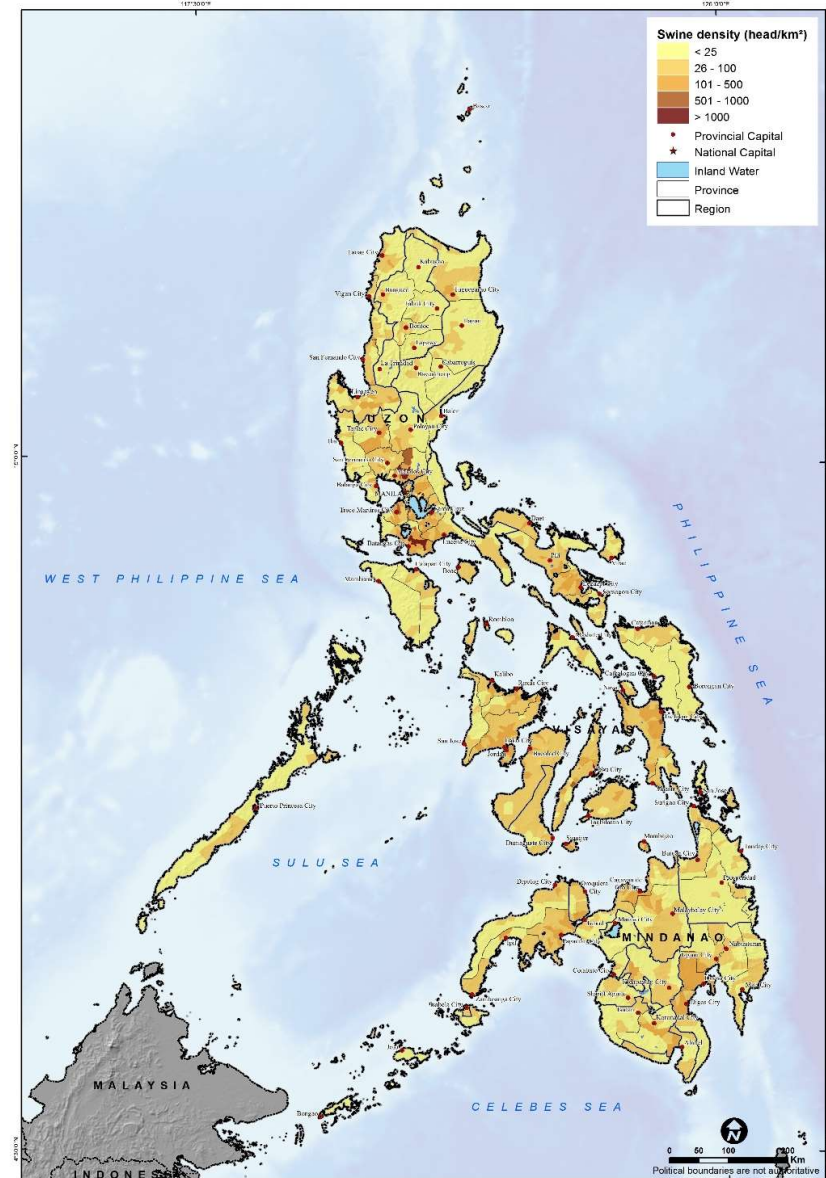
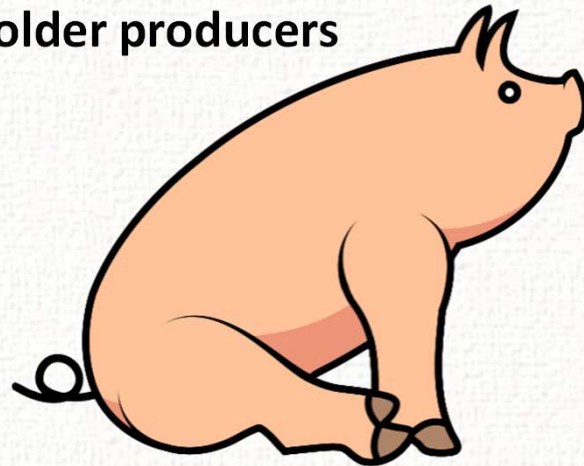

The Philippine Swine Industry

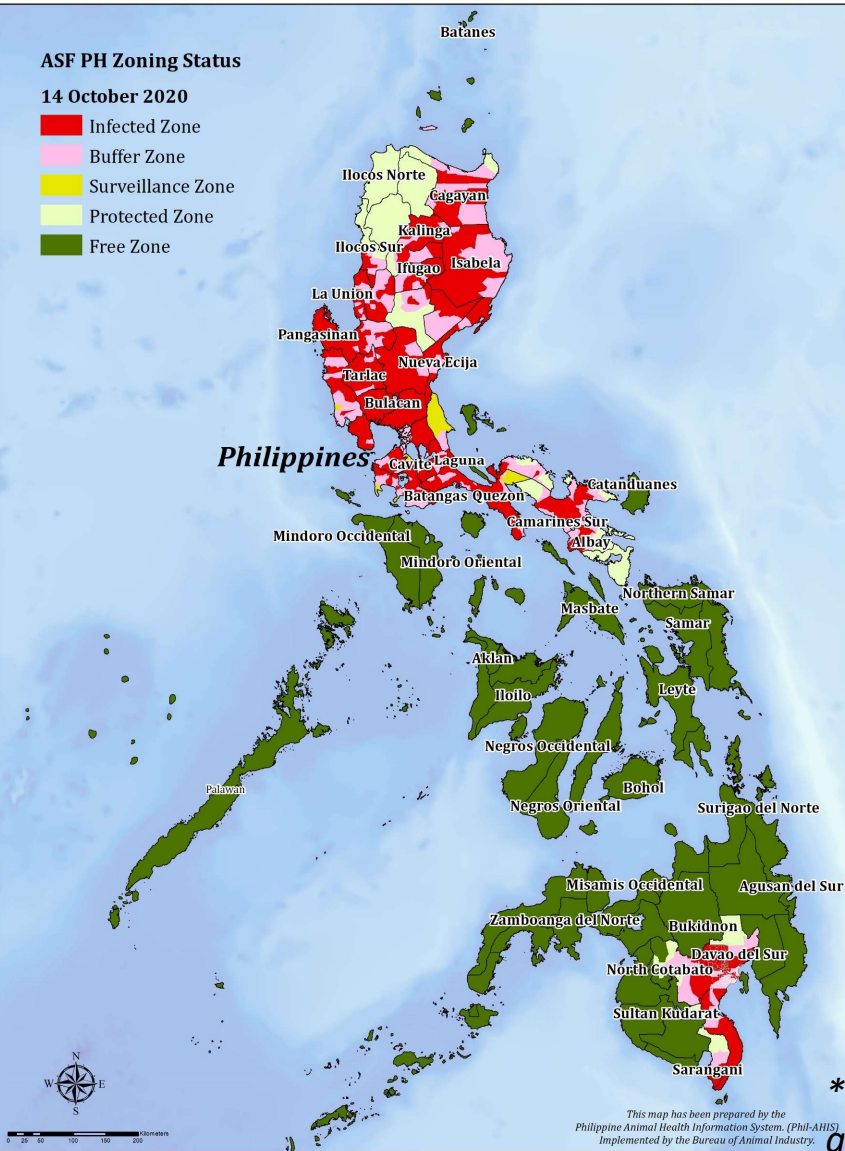
- **Pork** is an **important source of animal protein**
- Demand for pork has **historically** been increasing with an **annual per capita consumption of 15.07 kg.**
- Social inclusion - **64%** of the 12.5 million swine inventories in 2016 was **produced by backyard or smallholder producers**

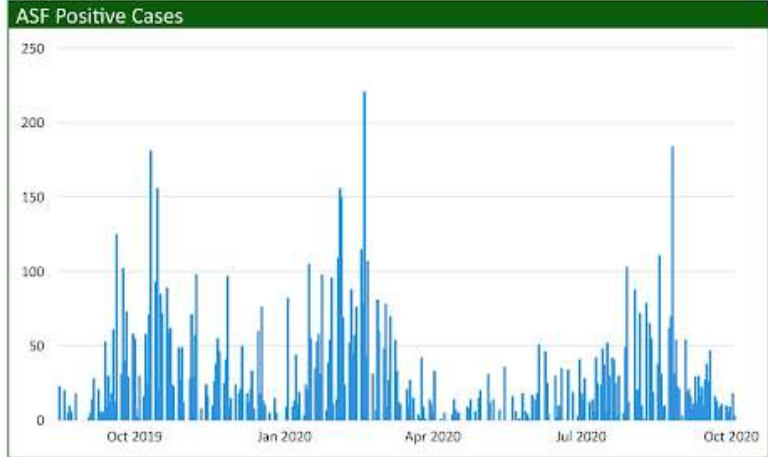

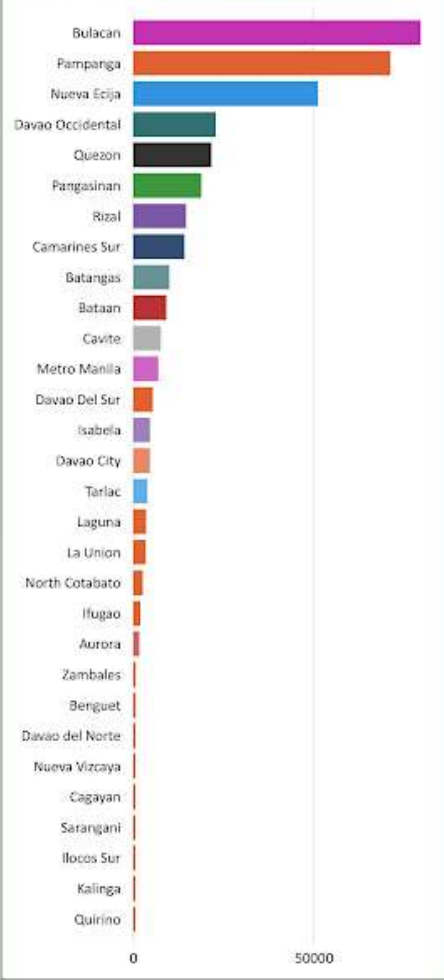
