### BIOGRAPHY

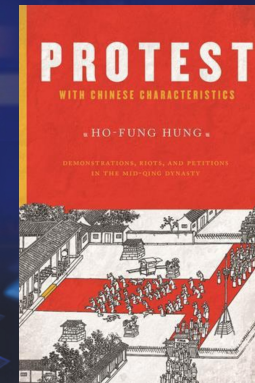
Prof. Ho-fung Hung is the Henry M. and Elizabeth P. Wiesenfeld Professor in Political Economy in the Department of Sociology and the Nitze School of Advanced International Studies at the Johns Hopkins University. He researches global capitalist transformation, nationalism, social movements, and Chinese development. He is the author of the *Protest with Chinese Characteristics* (2011) and *The China Boom: Why China Will Not Rule the World* (2015), both with Columbia University Press. His works appear in *Review of International Political Economy, Development and Change, Annual Review of Sociology, American Sociological Review, American Journal of Sociology*, and others. His publications have been translated into at least ten different languages.
