Award Value/ Benefits	 Scholarships and prizes, ranging in value from HK\$4,000 to HK\$20,000 would be offered subject to the funding availability and the quality of applications received. A maximum of 3 Scholarships with a cash prize of HK\$10,000 would be conferred. A maximum of 5 eligible applications may also be shortlisted to receive a Certificate of Merit and a cash prize of HK\$4,000. Application demonstrating exceptional project excellence would be conferred with a cash prize of HK\$20,000, The total number of Scholarship is conferred and granted at the sole discretion of the Occupational Safety & Health Council.
Eligibility	 Applications should be in pursuit of Postgraduate programmes or Undergraduate/ sub-degree programmes. Applicant should be a student enrolling in an award-bearing programme of duration of not less than one year offered by a recognized local post-secondary institution in Hong Kong. Applicants can be from government-funded postgraduate, undergraduate or sub-degree studies on a part-time or full-time mode. Both local and non-local students are eligible. Applicants should be holder of Hong Kong Identity Card, The submission of applicant's project work should have been completed in the recent two academic years, i.e. 2022/23 and 2023/24. Applications should be made via the project supervisor, subject leader, or programme leader with the endorsement from the Head of academic department which offers the course programme with the consent of the applicants. Applicant is only eligible to receive this Scholarship once throughout the study.
