

Link University Scholarship 2024 - Year 2 - 4 University Studies

Link University Scholarship aims to reduce barriers to education by providing non-means-tested scholarships to outstanding local Hong Kong students who are the first in the three generations within their families to attend universities in Hong Kong.

Scholarship Benefits	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) HK\$ 20,000 per awardee 2) A wide range of events and workshops to broaden scholars' social perspectives 3) Various volunteer activities to encourage scholars to participate in community services. 4) Opportunity to join summer internship and management trainee programme
Eligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The first-generation university student from his/her family (i.e. his/her grandparents and parents <u>do NOT</u> hold any degree from any university) to study at one of the Hong Kong's universities, and is able to provide one of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. A recommendation letter by the principal or teacher of his/her previous secondary school*, or ii. A declaration issued by Home Affairs Department of HKSAR* (Please click here to learn more about the details of administration of Declarations/ Oaths); <p>* The relevant templates will be provided after the application is open</p> 2) A full-time student who will continue their Year 2/3/4 full-time bachelor's study at one of the Hong Kong's universities; 3) Having a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and eligible for next year's admission by a Hong Kong university; 4) A local student (Please click here to review the Education Bureau's definition of Local Students regarding admission to post-secondary programmes); 5) Aged 25 below (i.e. born on or after 1 September 1999); and 6) Proactively participating in community services
