Residence Scholarship Scheme for Student Athletes

Regulations

Number and Value of the award

There shall be a maximum of 40 awards, in the value of HK\$15,900@ per annum.

Terms and conditions

- 1. Nominations of new students shall be made by Physical Education Section through the Student Athletes Admission Scheme.
- 2. Nominations of current students who admitted through the Student Athletes Admission Scheme shall be made by Physical Education Section basing on the following criteria:
 - i) students' continued satisfactory academic performance with a Cumulative GPA of 2.5 by the end of semester B; <u>and</u>
 - ii) students' continued satisfactory sports performance and team contribution as determined by the Physical Education Section.
- 3. The award shall be paid by two equal instalments, i.e. one in semester A while another in semester B to cover students' hostel fees. No cash award will be granted to awardees in any case.
- 4. Physical Education Section may reserve the right to withhold the payment for Semester B if the student does not make satisfactory sports performance and team contribution in Semester A of the same year.
- 5. Accommodation is provided in a double room at the University's Student Residence for Semesters A and B.
- 6. The Scholarship may be suspended for any period when
 - i) the student is absent from the University, such as enrolling in a year-long job placement scheme or other interruption; or
 - ii) the student is absent/ has withdrawn/ has been removed from University's sports teams.
- 7. Nominations by Physical Education Section shall reach Student Finance Team of Student Development Services and Student Residence Office by the following deadlines:
 - i) Current students: by the mid of June every year.
 - ii) New Students: by the mid of August every year.

8. Students are required to follow the residence application as stated by Student Residence Office. Due to the limited number of residence places, there is always a high demand for on-campus accommodation; priority will be given to applicants who apply for the Student Residence. Student Residence offers shared double rooms. Indication of hall, roommate and room type will be considered as far as possible, but the request may not be served. Late application will not be considered.

<u>Remarks</u>:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
