Outstanding Athletes Entrance Scholarships for Local Students

Regulations

Number and Value of the Scholarships

International Level: A maximum of 10 awards, HK\$80,000@ per annum. Regional Level: A maximum of 20 awards, HK\$30,000@ per annum. Elite Level: A maximum of 30 awards, HK\$15,000@ per annum.

<u>Eligibility</u>

The scholarships shall be granted to full-time UGC-funded undergraduate freshmen who have been admitted to CityU via the University's Student-Athlete Admission Scheme.

Tenure

The scholarships are tenable for two to six years, depending on the duration of the registered UGC-funded undergraduate programme of the student.

Requirement for Scholarship Renewal

The renewal of scholarships shall be subject to:

- 1. students' continued satisfactory academic performance with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 by the end of Semester B each year; <u>and</u>
- 2. students' continued satisfactory sports performance and team contribution as determined by the Physical Education Section.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The scholarships shall be paid in two equal instalments by crediting to the student's personal bank account. The first instalment is payable in the middle of Semester A, while the second instalment is payable at the end of Semester B. Nevertheless, the Physical Education Section may reserve the right to withhold the payment for Semester B if the student does not perform satisfactory sports performance and team contribution in Semester A of the academic year.
- 2. The scholarships may be suspended for any period when
 - i) the student is absent from the University, such as enrolling in a year-long job placement scheme or other interruption; or
 - ii) the student has withdrawn/been removed from the University's sports teams.

- 3. The sports achievement/performance of the candidates will be recognized in the recent year (i.e. 1 Sep 2023 31 Aug 2024).
- 4. Nominations shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Team and the winners of the scholarships will be selected by a Selection Panel to be chaired by the Associate Director (Physical Education) of Student Development Services.

<u>Remark</u>:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
