Stewart Wong Table-tennis Awards

(王世濤乒乓球獎)

Regulations

The Awards funded by Mr. Stewart Wong have been established for the Table-tennis Team players of the City University of Hong Kong with effect from the 2014/15 academic year. The following regulations shall apply as of 2024/25:

1. *There shall be a maximum of HK\$50,000 for a number of “Team Awards” and “Individual Awards”:*

2. *The selection criteria for each individual award are as follows:*
 - a) **Most Valuable Players (MVP)** is to be selected by the team coach based on the performance of the player(s) in recent sports competitions.*
 - b) **Most Dedicated Award** is to be selected by the team coach based on the performance of the players and his/her contribution to the team.*
 - c) **Attendance Award** shall be offered to player(s) who have obtained an overall attendance rate of 90% or above in the training.*
 - d) **Academic Improvement Award** shall be offered to player(s) who have shown the biggest improvement in their CGPA in the recent two semesters in CityU, and such an improvement as reflected in CGPA should be > 0.1.*
3. *Both Team and Individual Awards shall be awarded to UGC-funded student athletes who have obtained satisfactory academic performance with a CGPA of 2.0 or above in a CityU programme.*

4. *Nominations shall be made by the coach of CityU Sports Teams, and winners of the awards shall be selected by the Selection Panel chaired by the Associate Director (Physical Education) of Student Development Services and/or his delegate(s) by May of each year.*
5. *The Awards shall be presented at the CityU Sports Team Annual Prize Presentation Ceremony cum Team Gathering.*

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
