## We Care for CityUHK Sports Awards

## **Regulations**

The Alumni Relations Office (ARO) collaborates with the Physical Education (PE) Section of Student Development Services (SDS) to launch a crowdfunding campaign. Donations raised will be used to set up the "We Care for CityU Sports Awards". The awards are designated to cater to the new and changing needs for the provision of adequate support to nurture the growth of our full-time CityU student-athletes in personal, academic, and career development with effect from the 2022/23 academic year. The following regulations shall apply as of 2024/25:

- 1. There shall be two types of awards, namely **Student Awards** and **Team Awards**.
- 2. **Team Awards** shall be granted to team in recognition of the teams' outstanding performance and achievement in local sports competitions organized by The University Sports Federation of Hong Kong, China Limited (USFHK) or other universities of Hong Kong. The value of the awards depends on the results as achieved by the Sports Teams in the year:

 Champion
 : HK\$10,000 (Maximum)

 Second
 : HK\$7,500 (Maximum)

 Third
 : HK\$5,000 (Maximum)

 Forth
 : HK\$2,500 (Maximum)

- 3. **Student Awards** shall be granted to student-athletes in the amount ranging from HK\$1,000 to HK\$ 5,000 (maximum) in recognition of the student's outstanding sports performance and/or contribution to specific team development and achievement. The Awards shall be granted to athletes who shall meet the following criteria:
  - i. demonstrated good sports performance and achievements in local (such as USFHK competition) or international competitions; and
  - ii. have proven leadership and sportsmanship in the CityU sports team(s); and
  - iii. obtained satisfactory academic performance with CGPA 2.0 or above.
- 4. Nominations shall be made by the team managers and coaches of CityU Sports Team and the winners of the awards will be selected by a selection panel to be chaired by the Associate Director (Physical Education) of Student Development Services.

## Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
