He was the Secretary for the Environment, Hong Kong SAR Government, in 2012-2022, overseeing the issuance of various policy blueprints on climate change, energy saving, air quality, waste management, biodiversity etc. and leading Hong Kong towards carbon neutrality before 2050. He is currently Chairman of Wu Zhi Qiao (Bridge to China) Charitable Foundation, Distinguished Department of Architecture Fellow at The University of Hong Kong, and Honorary Professor at Hong Kong Chu Hai College.
