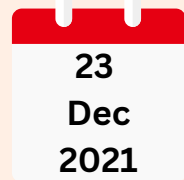


Christmas Walk with the Children

Owing to financial difficulties, these children seldom have the opportunity to travel far away from home to other districts in Hong Kong. Participating in such community service initiatives allowed volunteers to cultivate empathy towards underprivileged children and bring joy and laughter them in the festive season.

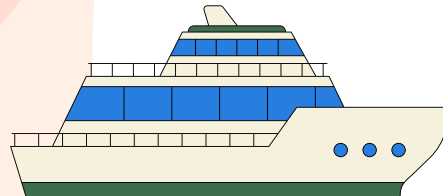
