#### **Tung Ping Chau**

Tung Ping Chau, like Hoi Ha Wan, has a healthy and rich coastal ecosystem in Hong Kong. The coverage and species diversity of coral communities in Tung Ping Chau Marine Park is one of the best in Hong Kong. Other marine lives like algae, marine invertebrates and fishes are also found in the water of Tung Ping Chau Marine Park.

#### **Strange Rocks**

The unique and renowned geological features provide many good scenic spots for sightseeing such as Kang Lau Shek, Lan Kwo Shui and Lung Lok Shui.
