Jockey Club Humanity Hall Alumni Association's Whole Person Development Scholarship (WPDS)

Regulations

The Jockey Club Humanity Hall Alumni Association has offered to donate \$5,000 to recognize an all-rounded resident with special talents who have contributions made to the Jockey Club Humanity Hall community and to encourage his/her continuous Whole Person Development through active participation and learning in residential life. The following regulations shall apply as of 2023/24:

1. *The award shall be known as “Jockey Club Humanity Hall Alumni Association’s Whole Person Development Scholarship”.*
2. *There shall be one award each year and the value of the award shall be \$5,000 in cash.*
3. *Eligibility:*
To be eligible for the award, the nominee must meet the following requirements at the time of nomination:
 - i. *Good academic achievements based on: a) GPA 3.0 or above in Semester A of the award year; or b) CGPA 3.0 or above by the end of Semester A of the award year;*
 - ii. *Has demonstrated outstanding contribution to building of the hall culture;*
 - iii. *Has been a resident of Jockey Club Humanity Hall and resided in the Hall for at least one full semester (summer term excluded);*
 - iv. *Will continue to reside in Jockey Club Humanity Hall in one of the semesters of the following academic year; and*
 - v. *Be a non-final year student at the time of nomination.*
4. *Conditions of Award Acceptance:*
 - i. *If a resident has reached the upper limit on the total amount of merit-based awards¹ of the University an undergraduate / sub-degree student may receive in an academic year (i.e. HK\$200,000), he/she is no longer eligible for the Scholarships.*
 - ii. *Should an award recipient fail to meet the requirements as stated in these Regulations or violate Regulations Governing Student Residence/ Hall Rules, the Student Residence Office or the Residence Master reserves the right to disqualify the award recipient.*
 - iii. *With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, scholarship recipients are expected to donate at least HK\$200 annually to CityU for student support purpose via “CityU Alumni Giving Club” after graduation.*

¹ Scholarships / Awards designated for exchange activities, placements, course-required projects and sports achievement are excluded.

Administrative Arrangements

Procedures and Time Schedule for the award:

a. Application

- i. Interested applicants should submit completed application forms.*
- ii. All application information has to be submitted via online application form from SRO Hall scholarship website by 23:59, 14 May 2024. Late submissions will not be considered.*

b. Nomination

- i. Student Residence Office will invite nomination from the Selection Panel chaired by the Residence Master of Jockey Club Humanity Hall during the selection of hall scholarship recipients of Jockey Club Humanity Hall Scholarship in April/May.*
- ii. Candidates will be evaluated and nominated by the Selection Panel according to their contributions to the hall community:*
 - **Personal Management:** *Academic Performance, Time Management, Ability to Relate to Others – a Holistic Balance between Study, Work and Leisure;*
 - **Contribution to Hall Life:** *Floor Participations, Hall Event Participations, Hall Organizational Work, Inter-hall Competitions, Inter-cultural Exchange, Intangible Efforts Dedicated; and*
 - **Contributions to the Wider Community:** *City U Organizational Work, Volunteer and Community Service, Special Contribution to his/her discipline.*

c. Results Announcement

- i. The results will be announced by May/June each year.*
- ii. All decisions by the Selection Panel are final. No further appeals will be accepted.*
