# Alumni Civility Hall (Hall 3) Sihe Feng Memorial Awards (校友樂禮堂馮思赫紀念獎)

## **Regulations**

Dr. YAN Fei, Associate Professor of Tsinghua University, has agreed to donate two annual scholarships to Alumni Civility Hall with effect from the 2016/17 academic year for five years. The following regulations shall apply as of 2023/24:

- 1. The Scholarships shall be known as the "Alumni Civility Hall (Hall 3) Sihe Feng Memorial Awards (校友樂禮堂馮思赫紀念獎)".
- 2. There shall be two awards per award year and the value of each award shall be HK\$5,000 in cash. One award will be granted to an Alumni Civility Hall resident who has made a special contribution towards the advancement of residents' sports activities; and the other will be awarded to an Alumni Civility Hall resident who has made a special contribution towards enhancing the overall hall ambience.

#### 3. Eligibility:

An applicant must meet the following requirements:

- i. A minimum CGPA of 2.5 or above;
- ii. Special contributions to the hall life in Alumni Civility Hall in particular, either residents' sports activities OR enhancing the overall hall ambience;
- ii. Be a resident of Alumni Civility Hall at the time of application;
- iii. Have resided at Alumni Civility Hall for no less than 2 semesters (summer term is not considered); and
- iv. Not a recipient of this scholarship in the past.

#### 4. Conditions of Award Acceptance:

- i. If a resident has reached the upper limit on the total amount of merit-based awards<sup>1</sup> of the University an undergraduate / sub-degree student may receive in an academic year (i.e. HK\$200,000), he/she is no longer eligible for the Scholarships.
- ii. Should the award recipient fails to meet the requirements as stated in these Regulations or violate Regulations Governing Student Residence/Hall Rules, the Student Residence Office or the Residence Master reserves the right to disqualified the award recipient.
- iii. With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, scholarship recipients are expected to donate at least HK\$200 annually to CityU for student support purpose via "CityU Alumni Giving Club" after graduation.

- 5. If in any year no student is found to be of sufficient merit, the Scholarships will be withheld. The remaining funding shall be carried forward to the next academic year.
- 6. Confirmation on the renewal of the Scholarships and the amount of the Scholarships will be sought from the donor before July 2024.

#### **Administrative Arrangements**

*Procedures and Time Schedule for the Scholarships:* 

- a. Application
  - i. Interested applicants should submit completed application forms.
  - ii. All application information has to be submitted via online application form from SRO Hall scholarship website by 23:59, 14 May 2024. Late submissions will not be considered.
- b. Selection Interview
  - i. Shortlisted candidates may be requested to attend an interview with a Selection Panel on a date to be announced by Alumni Civility Hall.
  - ii. The Selection Panel will comprise the Residence Master of Alumni Civility Hall, Director of SRO or his/her designate, a member of the Convocation or a staff member of the University.
- c. Results Announcement
  - i. The results will be announced by May/June each year.
  - ii. All decisions by the Selection Panel are final. No further appeals will be accepted.
